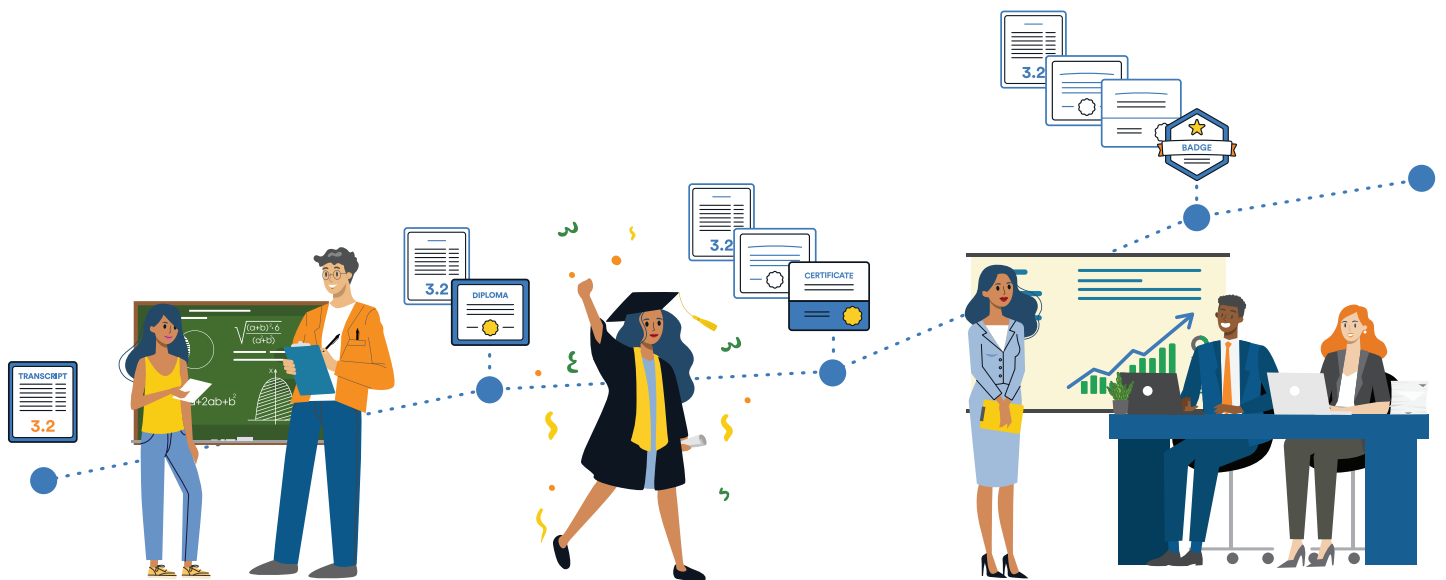

Under Pressure: The Financial Strain in UK Higher Education

UK universities are under growing financial pressure. Budget cuts and frozen tuition fees are forcing tough decisions, from course closures to major staff cuts.

Cardiff University, for example, is planning to cut nearly 10% of its academic staff¹, and Dundee may cut over 600 roles to address a £35M shortfall². And with **72% of institutions expected to run deficits**³, relying on international tuition is becoming more risky due to visa restrictions and global uncertainty.

UK tuition fees for domestic students have also been frozen at £9,250 since 2017, losing real value due to inflation. This has put growing financial pressure on universities, with nearly half of vice-chancellors expecting to run at a loss in 2024⁴. While raising fees could help, it's politically and socially unpopular. Many institutions have relied on higher-paying international students to offset the shortfall, but even those numbers are now declining.

Growing Support for Modular and Micro Learning

At the same time, modular learning and the UK's new Lifelong Learning Entitlement (LLE) are transforming how students access and pay for education. The House of Commons describes this as delivering a “radical shift in the tertiary education system, by unifying the student finance systems for further and higher education courses.”⁵

The LLE will enable learners to access short, flexible courses throughout their careers — but many universities still lack the systems needed to deliver, stack, and credential these modular pathways efficiently.

That's why credentialing deserves your focus. It's a core process in every institution — but when modernised, it can reduce costs, improve the student experience, and open new revenue streams.
